Course

Description

English for Health Sciences 2025



Course

Description

This course is for international undergraduate students majoring in nursing.

Participants will reflect on their own experiences in order to provide the basis for interactive communicative learning tasks with a focus on listening, speaking, and vocabulary development. The materials, along with students' own experiences, observations, and reflections, provide the basis for interactive-communicative learning tasks with a focus on listening, reading, speaking, and vocabulary development in health sciences. The course will also stress the need for clear and accurate use of language with the goal of building confidence and fluency in an academic setting.

This course consists of 19 content and language support classes held Monday to Friday from 0830 to 1230. Learn about Canadian culture and healthcare practices through a variety of afternoon activities, both indoor and outdoor in and around the capital city of Edmonton.
